Have you got a digital device at home that you no longer use or want? Maybe in a drawer, on a shelf, or under your bed?

Dig it out and donate it at a drop-off point near you between August and October. We'll collect all the donated devices from the drop-off points,

recondition them and donate them to local people who don't have access to a digital device.

Before we donate them on, we'll make sure every device is data sanitised. This means all data, such as photos and files, will be deleted and removed from the devices.

We'd love donations of mobile phones, laptops, tablets, monitors, keyboards and mice, as well as cables and chargers.
